PALACE OF VERSAILLES STARTS TO BE MADE (1634)

- The Palace Of Versailles was made by Louis XIV. This is because Louis XIV lived a very lavish and rich life. The palace costed a \$100 million. This money came from all of the countries they conquered. The palace had more than 700 rooms, 2000 windows, 1250 fireplaces, 67 staircases and was 1800 acres.



LOUIS XIV BECOMES KING (1643)

- Louis XIV was born on September 5, 1638. His father died when he was four. He seized the thrown. Later on he nicknamed himself the "Sun King" because he believed that everything revolved around him. France won tons of wars and became a very wealthy country due to him.



THE TENNIS COURT OATH (JUNE 20, 1789)

- The Tennis Court Oath started because the 3rd class was unhappy with the standards of living. They chose to stand on a tennis court until the king met their demands. This caused the king to change the laws and living standards.



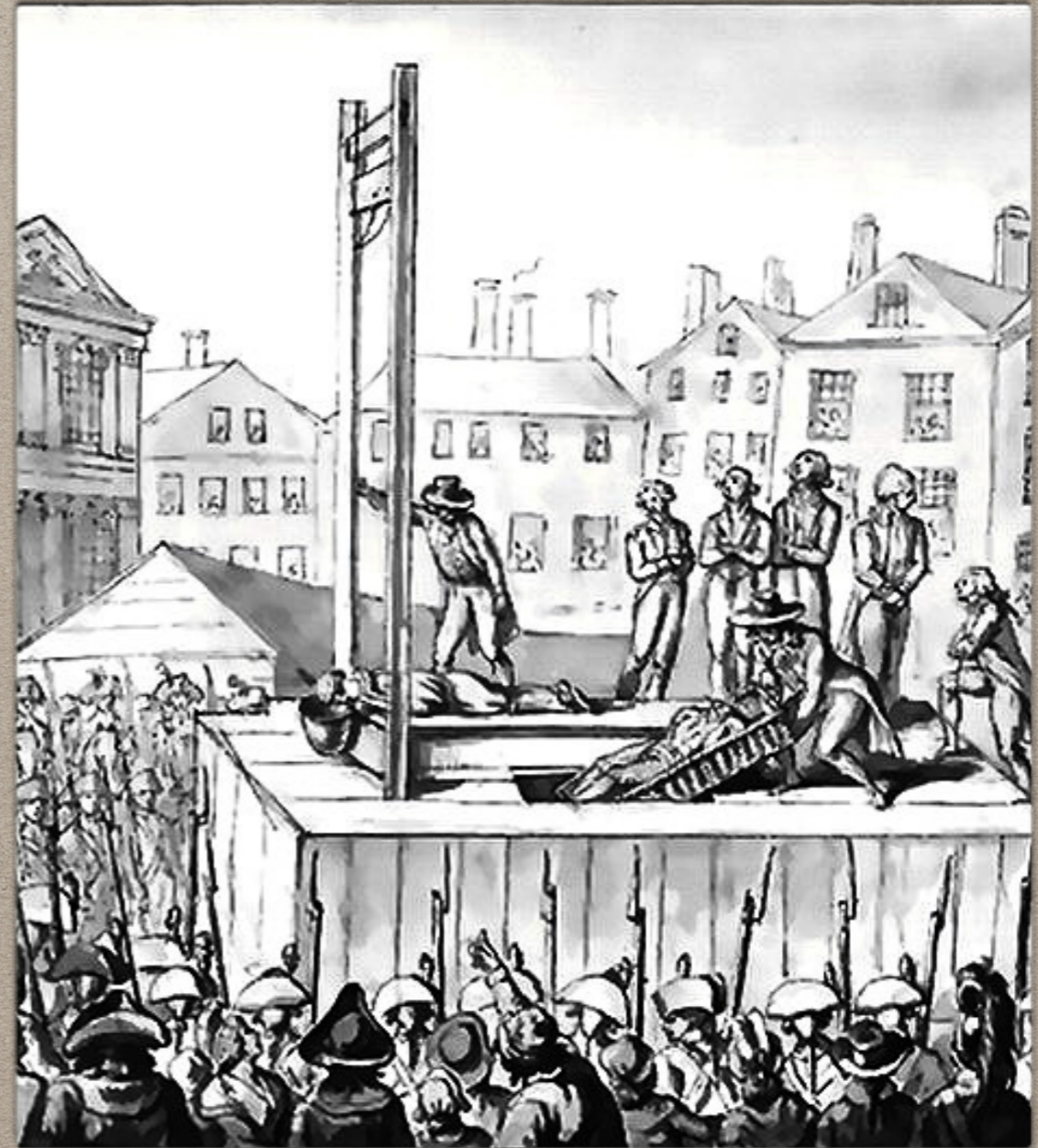
STORMING OF THE BASTILLE (JULY 14, 1789)

- The Storming of the Bastille took place as a protest. It also caused the king to change the law. Bastille was a fortress made in the 1300s. In the revolution it was used as a prison. There was about 1000 people at the Bastille that day. About 100 of those people were killed.



REIGN OF TERROR (SEPTEMBER 5, 1793)

- The Reign of Terror was started by Robespierre. Robespierre was the leader of the Jacobin group. He believed in human rights for the 3rd estate. He wanted to free the people effected by slavery and money issues. He killed 37,000 people. This was a massive point in the 3rd estate riots.



NAPOLEON RISES (MAY 18, 1804)

- Napoleon Bonaparte led many major wars. He took over the government and later became the Emperor of France. He won the vast majority of the wars he started. His army kept growing until the Battle of Russia. He had 500,000 troops at the start of the battle.
