



Digital Awareness Infographic

The goal of this assignment is for you to develop the skills to research and gather reliable information online and reflect on your digital footprint and online presence.

For this assignment you will:

- Share how your digital footprint can impact your future education, job and career prospects.
- Describe the key messages around digital footprints and learn how you will be able to manage your digital footprint responsibly.
- Learn to search accurately for the information you are looking for.
- Think critically about the material you are viewing.
- Connect with knowledgeable people and sources and be able to store and organize the information you gather in a useful and accessible manner.

You are going to be demonstrating each of the above tasks and recording your information in an infographic which you will then be posting to the **Digital Literacy 10 Page** in your blog. There are a number of sites with which you can complete your infographic (Piktochart is a free site that works well with your blog, though as long as there is an embed code available you are free to use any site you like)

You will need to watch the video for each section and respond to the questions in each section in a thoughtful and reflective manner. You should also, where possible, look to use relevant media and incorporate it into each section of your infographic. You will also need to ensure that your infographic is neat, and presentable and that the information is easy to read and digest.

Digital Footprint Section

5. Pick one of the sites that came up in your search and create a proper citation for that site.

Your infographic is due by October 7th and must be uploaded to your Edublogs account. We expect that the tone of this assignment will be considerate and respectful, and use language that is inclusive, appropriate, and appealing to the Heritage Woods community. Your response will be reviewed and if there are concerns or questions with your response you may be contacted by one of the COL teachers. If there is any evidence of plagiarism your response will be considered incomplete.

Possible digital tools to use might be: Piktochart, Canva, etc.
