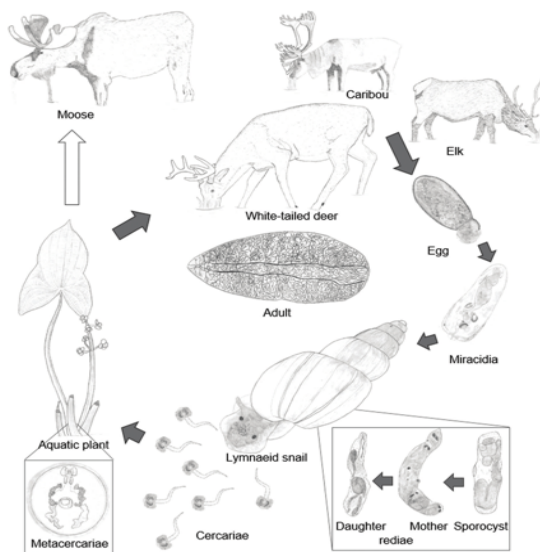


The Latin name of moose is *Alce Americano*. Common English name for moose is moose/ elk in british. First nations call moose the same as common English

Moose reproduces sexually. Not asexual



Moose eat leaves, bark, pine cones, twigs, buds of trees and shrubs, and water lilies they are herbivores

-Wolves, grizzly bears, black bears and humans all hunt and eat moose. And people feed dogs moose antlers

-Lakes and ponds provide enough water for moose. Soil, water and sunlight provides plants (food) for moose.

People use moose for food and designing art work (their antlers)

The way people get moose is by hunting & killing and there is a moose farm in Russia

-protein in meat. Bone marrow. Tons of vitamins and nutrients.
