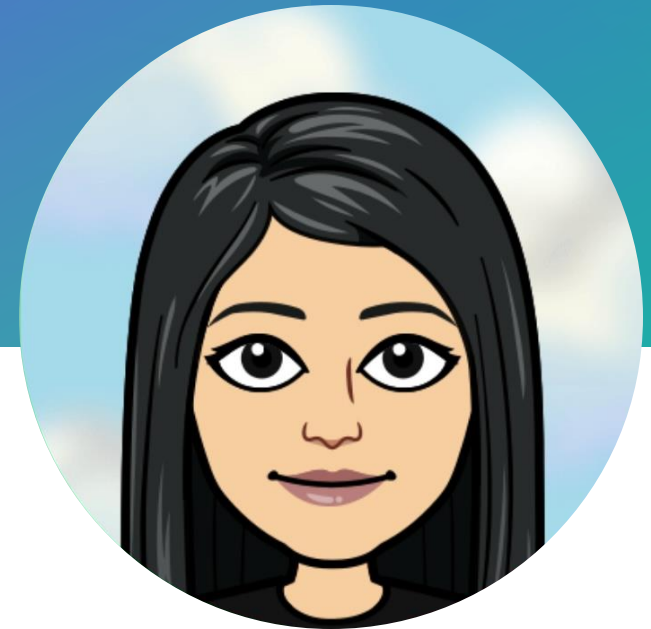
The three Digital Literacy teachers created from an app called Bitmoji

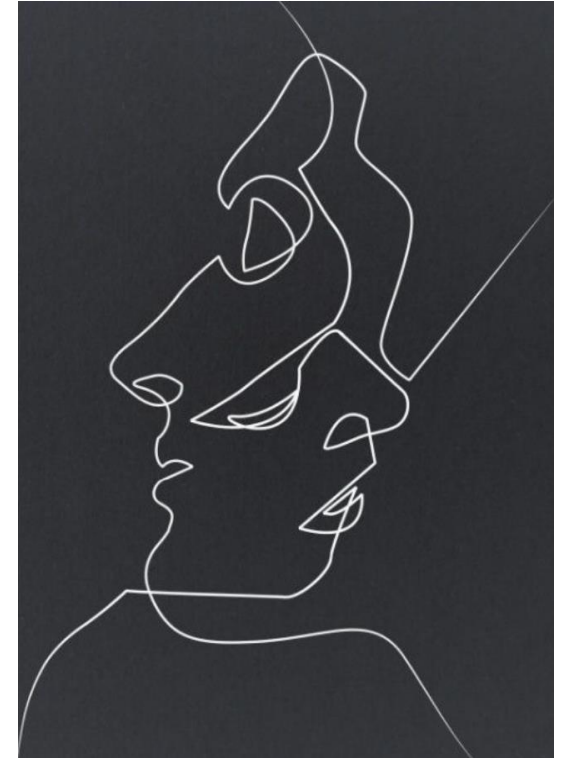
