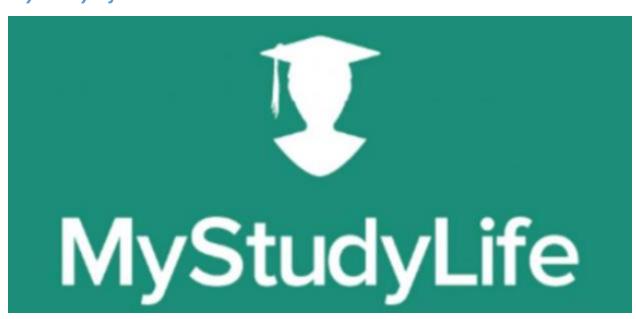

- Simple and easy to use

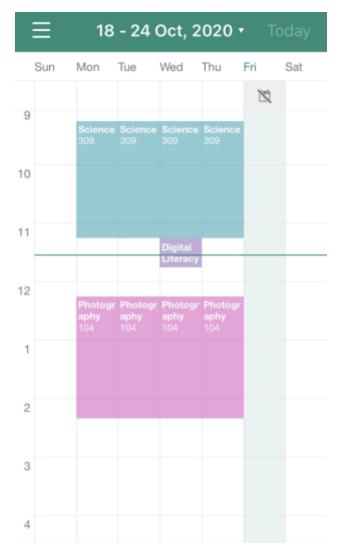
Disadvantages of the App
